

1. SURVEY NUMBER THREE - REVISION FOLLOWING COVID-19

This survey is an important way to collect up-to-date information about the views of the local communities in the Chesil Bank Parish to help create its Neighbourhood Plan, which is being developed through a project called Vision4Chesil. This survey is an abbreviated form of the first two surveys we undertook. We are concerned that some of the responses you made previously may have changed as a result of Covid-19 and the impact it has had on all our lives. This is why we are giving you the opportunity not only to revisit some of those questions but also to add some additional ones.

We would like to encourage each member of your household to complete the survey. We would also very much like to hear from the younger members of your household so we have compiled a separate survey of questions for any child in your household between the ages of 9 and 18.
