held in all 4 parishes. The group agreed to defer but noted that many may be on holiday in July/August so to look at dates in September. The consultation group will now commence with the preparations. Items for the options consultation are the maps of the parish boundary, extracts from the design codes. Call for sites information and maps of the green spaces.

SS suggested that Fleet could go first and be the trial event and this would be repeated in all of the parishes and be open to anyone one from each of the parishes. Also, the group could carry out an event with the Parish Council and other Steering group members as a trial. DT noted he may not be available in early September.

DT had provided a paper on the organising of the consultations which the group will look into and report back to the NPSG on 21st June. It was noted that the VH in Abbotsbury will reopen after the preschool have closed for the summer. PB will confirm dates in Abbotsbury and any Covid restrictions, SS & JC will look at the Church for Fleet, MTH will book Portesham and CK will book LH.

The group then discussed the AECOM reports that had been commissioned and if the group should speak to those who came forward with sites prior to the consultation. JW explained that not all groups have gone back to the landowners it really depends on the detail of the sites. Some members feel that those who put sites forward should be informed in advance out of courtesy. JW commented that if sharing this info that they are aware that this cannot be changed as the report was prepared by an external body. Care would be needed when giving this information out. The reports can still be commented on at the events the same as all those residents who wish to attend. It was also suggested that Dorset Council should be contacted on the issues of some of the sites regarding highways. By pushing the consultations back this would allow time to gather feedback from Dorset Council.

The two AECOM reports will be circulated to all steering group members.

21/05-6 Finance report to date

MTH reported no expenditure since the last meeting. The underspend of the grant has been returned to Locality.

21/05-7 Budget for 2021-22- DT had prepared a budget for consideration. Further information is required for the printing of the event. It was suggested that the Survey Monkey may no longer required, DT was concerned that the data will be lost if there is no subscription, JW explained that the group could download all the data prior to closing any account. It was confirmed that the grant funding is available on a financial limit basis not a timescale, but it is hoped that most are completed in 2 years. Any underspend
