


CHESIL BANK NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN NEWSLETTER NUMBER 16, JUNE 2023

Following the completion of the Examiner's Report on the 23rd May 2023, the Neighbourhood Plan needs to be modified to incorporate the changes stipulated in the report. There were 31 Policies identified in the plan which went to the Examiner, and of these 2 have been deleted and 6 are subject to minor modifications. Work has now started on updating the Plan and will be made available as soon as possible. The Examiner's Report is now in the Public Domain and Dorset Council have started preparations for the Referendum. I am delighted to report that CBPC gave their formal consent to the proposed modifications in the Examiner's Report on the 5th June 2023, which means that Dorset Council can now seek a formal decision to proceed to Referendum from the Planning Portfolio, which takes 1-2 weeks. Following that decision then DC is obliged to hold a referendum within 56 working days. This means that a referendum is not likely to take place until September 2023. You will see from the attached diagram that the only remaining task is to arrange the Referendum, following which the Plan will be made, assuming that more than 50% of those who vote, support the Plan.

This is a major milestone in the development of our Neighbourhood Plan and



the Steering Group was delighted that the Examiner commended the Group for their efforts in producing a Plan which is concise but comprehensive, logical, informative and well-illustrated.
